How is Nationals going to work?

You must have participated in two (2) NAGDA events, placing 1st—3rd in one of the events in order to be qualified for the National Championships, April 4th and 5th at ECHO Hunt Club in Stratton, CO or if you and your dog placed in the top five at the 2007 Nationals and you have participated at two events you are also qualified to participate. If you have qualified to compete at Nationals you will run two (2) days, Friday and Saturday, April 4th and 5th in order to qualify for the finals on Sunday, April 6th.

Participants will run once on Friday and once on Saturday, those two scores will be combined. On Saturday evening the top 5 scores in each division will be announced and given run times for the final championship run on Sunday. All participants will start with a score of "0" on Sunday. The participant with the highest score in their division will be named the National Champion of that division and will receive the prizes listed.

Remember, **all entries must be received by March 29th** to avoid a \$25.00 late charge per entry. You may pay by check, money order or credit card. You must also R.S.V.P. for the banquet by March 29th, there will be a ten dollar charge per person at the

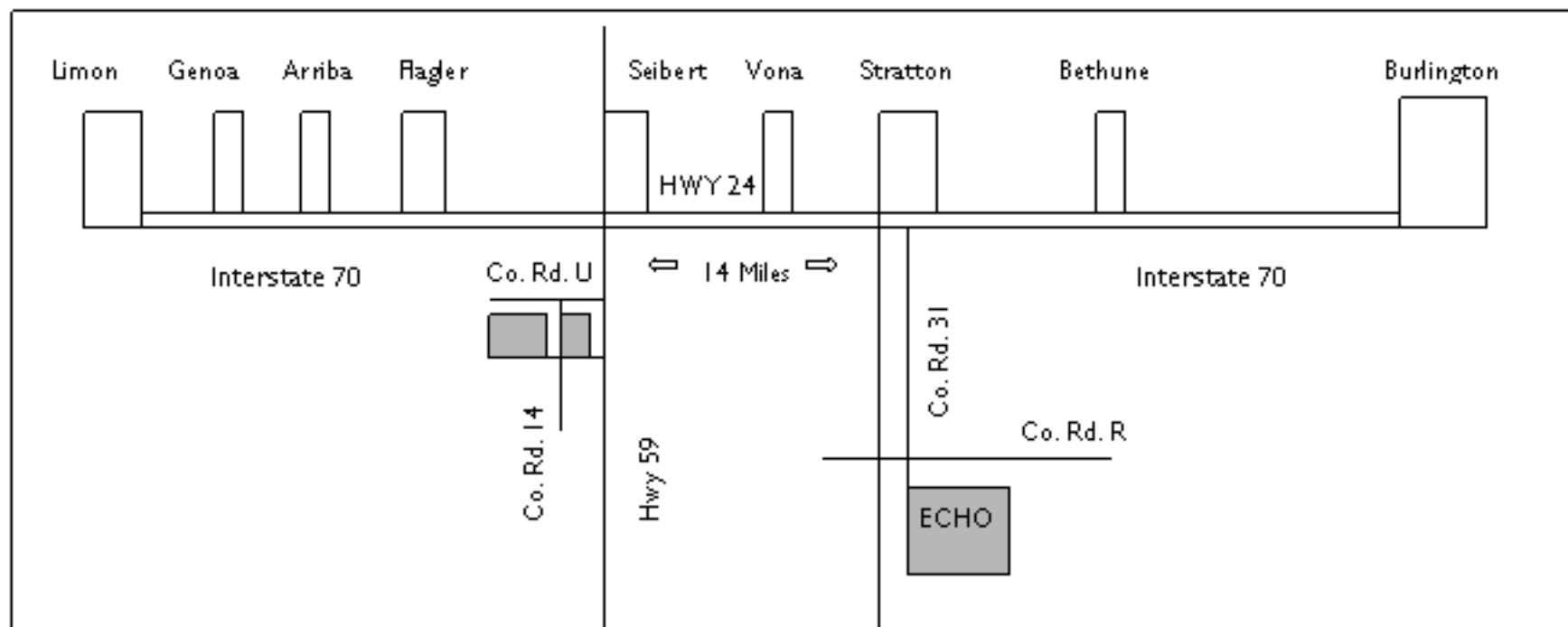
A local vender has agreed to provide concessions this year. Please support them!!!!

Directions

The ECHO Clubhouse is located just south of Stratton, CO. As you exit 419 take a right and then an immediate left onto the frontage road that runs along side eastbound I-70. Follow this road to the east a 1/4 mile, the road will then turn you to the south. You are now on County Road 31, you will remain on this road for 3 miles. At the intersection of Country Roads 31 and R you are at ECHO.

The NAGDA Trial area will be held on ECHO property located south of Seibert, CO. To reach the property exit at Seibert and turn south. Travel approximately 1/2 mile and turn right or west on Road U. Go one mile to Road 14, turn left or south and go two miles. You have reached the trial area, please follow the signs from there.



There will be practice fields available at the ECHO property at Stratton, CO.

Prices for birds are \$17.00 for pheasants and \$12.00 chukars.

Reservations for field times are requested in advance.

Doubles: Three (3) pheasants, Three (3) chukar

E-Collars are permitted

All dogs must be kept on leash at all times

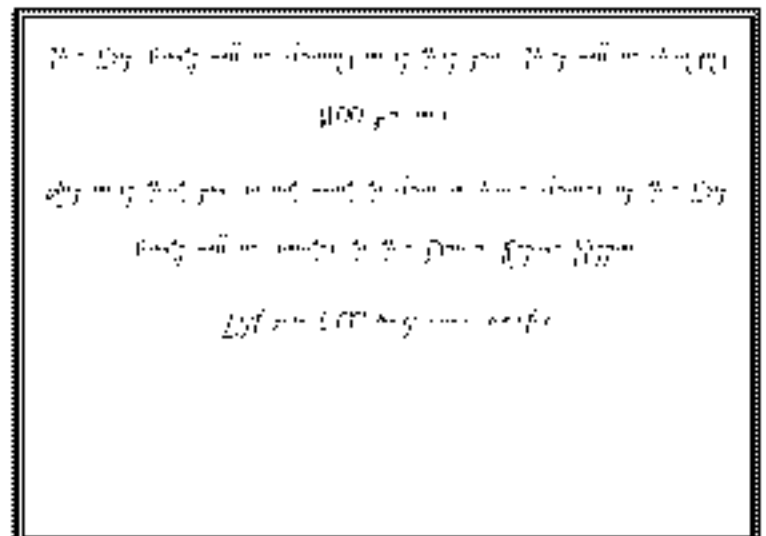
There will be a grievance committee on site
